Parents often ask what they can do to help improve their child's reading comprehension



and motivation. One of the best things you can do is discuss what your child is reading with them.

Here are some example, discussion prompts:

- *What would you have done if you were the character?
- *When you read, what pictures did you see in your head? How did you imagine it looked like?
- *How would you have felt if you were the character?
- *Does the character remind you of someone you know?
- *What surprised you about the plot?

Listening to audible books is another great way to build comprehension and enjoyment.
