Dear Snow Horse Families and Students:

As the school year draws to a close, the need to slow the spread of COVID-19 continues to be a State and District priority. We are committed to ensuring that our students along with staff are protected during these unprecedented times. As communicated last week by our Superintendent, Davis School District will be extending end-of-year procedures to accommodate for current conditions and to prepare for the next school year.

Schools will be following district-wide guidelines for ending remote learning, grades, device return and for returning personal belongings (including yearbooks). Although logistics will be individualized based on each school's needs, the following timeline will be followed:

- May 15th remote learning with instruction support and digital curriculum delivery will end.
- Device Return for Snow Horse Elementary will begin on Wednesday, May 20th.
- May 29th Report cards will be available through MyDSD
- June 1st Class lists will be finalized. *Educational concern forms and teacher requests are closed for consideration at this time.*

Please watch for the specific procedures and instructions provided the first of May. It will be critical to adhere to these procedures to maximize safety.

As we prepare for the start of the 2020 - 2021 school year, I hope you will join me in welcoming our newest staff members. Mrs. Tiffany Strong has been hired to teach 4th grade, and Ms. Ella Bingham will be our new librarian. Their biographies are included in this week's stampede.

We appreciate your continued support and patience as we navigate the end of year during unprecedented times. We are all in this together!
